Dear Parents and Friends,

This letter is to give you information about registration at Grace Lutheran Church and Schools for the 2010-2011 academic year. However, I want to begin by letting you know how much we appreciate having your children here at Grace. From kindergarten through eighth grade, we have had such a great student body this year. It is a privilege to see all of these young people receiving a quality education in a secure, Christian environment. They will benefit from this strong foundation as they eventually move on to high school and college.

Our registration process this year continues to be very important. In the last few years, we have worked very hard to maintain an excellent teacher to student ratio to create the best possible learning environment for your students. We have done this in spite of enrollment declines during these tough economic times. We will continue to maintain these educational goals for the next academic year. It is very important for you to register early to assure a place for next year. All classes will be filled based on the order in which we receive registrations.

A registration form is enclosed with this letter. I encourage you to fill it out and return it with your full or first registration installment as soon as possible. The registration fee is the same as last year (\$210) and can be paid on your credit card, by cash or check. It can be paid all at once, or in three installments of \$70 due no later than February 26, March 26, and April 23. If you need tuition assistance, please make a note on your registration form.

1. All students are expected to respect the spiritual values taught at Grace Lutheran School, including attendance at worship services.
2. In order to receive the member tuition rate, our family promises to abide by the Grace Lutheran Church and Schools' membership covenant.
3. We will carefully observe the rules and regulations of the school as printed in the Grace Lutheran Family Handbook.
4. The teacher has full discretion in the classroom discipline of my/our child(ren). (A copy of our discipline code is contained in the Family Handbook and from each classroom teacher).
5. My/our assistance and cooperation with the teachers is expected in order to assure completion of all homework assignments.
6. Tuition does not pay the full cost of my/our child's education and I understand that my/our support and willingness to help in various areas are required to maintain a quality education at Grace Lutheran School. Our family agrees to donate 30 hours of volunteer service to the school/church. Additionally we agree to practice good stewardship through regular Bible study, prayer, and cheerful giving to the ministries at Grace.
7. I/we assume financial responsibility for my/our child(ren) and agree to meet all financial obligations as due.
8. We will sincerely and faithfully have the child apply himself/herself to the studies assigned.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Full Tuition Payment** due July 1<sup>st</sup>. This option entitles the responsible party to a 2% discount. This payment must be paid directly to the school office by the due date. (\*\*\*)See note if payment is not received by the deadline.)

\_\_\_\_\_ **Half-year Payment** due July 1<sup>st</sup> and Dec. 1<sup>st</sup>. This option entitles the responsible party to a 1% discount. This payment must be paid directly to the school office by the due date. (\*\*\*)See note if payment is not received by the deadline.)

\_\_\_\_\_ **Monthly Payments through FACTS** This option entitles the responsible party to budget payments over twelve (12) months through the FACTS Management Company. Payments can be made from checking, savings or credit card (2.5% service fee), beginning June and ending May of the following year.

\*\*\*Note: As stated above under this option, discounts will be offered, but will be voided if payment is not received by the deadline date. All families selecting this option will be asked to complete a FACTS Tuition Agreement Form if the tuition payment is not received by the deadline.

## GRACE LUTHERAN SCHOOL TUITION RATES, 2010-2011\*

Tuition - The following rates are based on a 12 month automatic withdrawal payment schedule from June through May. If payment is made annually in a lump sum by July 1, a 2% discount is available. Semi-annual payments paid by July 1 and December 1 receive a 1% discount. Payments received after these dates will incur a late fee.
